



Dr. Janglin (John) Chen is a Vice President of Industrial Technology Research Institute (ITRI) in Taiwan, and the General Director of ITRI's Display Technology Center. Prior to Joining ITRI, Dr. Chen was a Research Fellow of Eastman Kodak Company in Rochester, New York, where he held many R&D managerial positions from 1982 to 2006. He is the author of sixty technical articles, and has 34 issued US Patents. A native of Taiwan, Dr. Chen holds a Ph.D. degree from NYU /Polytechnic University in Brooklyn, New York (1982), and is a graduate of Senior Executive Program, Stanford University, CA.
